The Embassy of Mexico to the United States of America presents its compliments to non-resident Embassies accredited before the Government of Mexico and has the honor to refer to the COVID-19 vaccination certificate and the COVID-19 booster vaccination card issued by the Secretariat of Health of Mexico to all persons that have been vaccinated in the country; have a unique population registry code (CURP); have registered at MIVACUNA website, and have a vaccination card that shows the name of the vaccine manufacturer and its lot number.

In this regard, the Embassy is attaching a sample of the COVID-19 booster vaccination card aimed at obtaining the relevant recognition of those countries that require proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 in order to facilitate the entrance of travelers who have been vaccinated in Mexico. The COVID-19 booster vaccination card includes the following information:

1. Header
2. Personal data
 - Full name
 - Gender
 - Age
 - CURP
3. Place of vaccination (state and county)
4. Vaccine data
 - Manufacturer
 - Lot number
 - Administration date for each dose
 - Name and stamp of the health provider.
